

## Meeting Minutes – Community Facility Task Force

Wednesday, January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2017

- The meeting began at 5:30 p.m.
- Those in attendance included Connie Denk, Sue Druschke, Steve Huebbe, Deb Hunt, Julie Laabs, John Linzmeier, Pete Olig, Brandon Platten, Jeff Sabel, Clint Selle, John Thews, Bob Wallander, and Jenniffer Zutz. Todd Bergmann attended on behalf of the Valders Journal.
- The group reviewed the suggested renovations and additions. The initial budget numbers were also reviewed (See Attached “Preliminary Budget Analysis”), with the preface that the numbers were preliminary and no decisions have been made. Additionally, much discussion still needs to continue, including prioritization of items and potential community input through a survey.
- Additional discussion ensued including:
  - o Consideration for resurfacing the track area;
  - o Move the health and Community rooms in the suggested additional athletic area to provide more flexible athletic space;
  - o Add new athletic space by the old gym in the middle school;
  - o Move the proposed new athletic space further east to save the softball diamond;
  - o Move the proposed athletic area to the elementary/bus pad;
  - o Provide a combination of having some athletic space and community room by the current gym area and add a larger athletic space by the old gym by the middle school;
  - o Consider a phased approach for the various renovations/repairs/upgrades;
  - o Re-imagine the use of the old locker rooms on the ground floor of the high school;
  - o Add charging stations in the cafetorium;
  - o Create signage for the high school gym façade and other areas to help direct visitors.
- Clint will work on the suggested changes for the next meeting.
