

Meeting Minutes – Community Facility Task Force

Tuesday, May 23rd, 2017

- The meeting began at 5:30 p.m.

- The group reviewed the Technology Education floor plan proposed changes and additions, which includes new construction for tech ed and a greenhouse, removing a wall for aquaponics, as well as closing off parts of hallways to create more storage area (See Attached).
- The group reviewed the multi-school survey regarding 1:1 technology survey that was conducted a few weeks ago (See Attached).
- The School Perceptions survey was also reviewed. Some of the discussion included review of costs, review of the tax impact, review of individual questions, and some discussion of Open House meetings and what needs to be covered. The discussion also included the possibility of using some fund balance support from the District. Regarding the technology question at the end of the survey, the group would like the technology subcommittee to meet again and review needs and what potential amount for the technology question may be more appropriate, as well as wordsmith the actual question.
- Discussion further followed regarding developing a flyer or asking the Valders Journal to run a series of articles regarding the various priorities and technology question. Another suggestion was during the Lions Club picnic this summer we could provide tours of the school district. Provide bag stuffers and flyers for area businesses and Piggly Wiggly is another idea to share necessary information.
