On Tuesday, April 2, 2024, residents of the Valders Area School District will vote on a \$1.3 million, 3-year operational referendum question. If the referendum is approved, VASD would use the funds to address operational needs across the entire district.

WHY IS AN OPERATIONAL REFERENDUM NEEDED?

In Wisconsin, a school district's revenue limit is directly linked to enrollment and state-approved adjustments. As a result of recent declines in state funding, VASD's revenue limit has not kept pace with inflation. Also, VASD has not levied to the allowed maximum. Like almost 400 other districts statewide, we are now turning to voters to approve an operational referendum to help fund our schools.

Inadequate funding from the state (2-year freeze)

Expiration of ESSER funds (COVID relief funds)





Rising inflation on all district operations

With your help passing the referendum, the District can continue to address facility needs. We will not need to increase the mill rate above the current level due to the District's accelerated repayment of debt (from the 2018 & 2022 referendums).
